# ASPT Committees—DFSC/SFSC

- ASPT V, pp. 17-21
- Faculty elected per Dept/School Guidelines
- Chair/Director is ex officio voting member and chairperson
  - Does not generally provide independent P&T assessment
  - Is required to provide independent report if voting in minority on P&T

#### ASPT Committees—CFSC

- ASPT IV, pp. 11-17
- Faculty elected per College guidelines
- Dean is *ex officio* voting member and chairperson
  - Does not generally provide independent P&T assessment
  - Is *required* to provide independent report if voting in minority on P&T

  - Appeals—3 processes
    - Annual Performance Evaluations
    - Post-Tenure Review
    - Non-reappointment
      - Due process/procedural review
      - NOT a review of DFSC judgment
  - Development & review of policies

#### ASPT Committees—FRC

- ASPT III, pp. 10-11
  - Elected faculty representing Colleges
  - Appellate body for
    - P&T
    - Performance evaluations and nonreappointments by CFSC in absence of DFSC (rare occurrence)
  - Faculty Dismissal (extremely rare)

  - Policy formulation, revision, interpretation
  - Reporting

# Academic Freedom, Ethics, and Grievance Committee

- ISU Policy 3.3.8: AFEGC considers ASPT decisions if appeal is based on alleged academic freedom or ethics violation
- By appellant or by appeal committee
- If AFEGC finds a violation, FRC decides if it "contributed significantly" to T/P denial
- CFSC may suspend appeal deliberations pending AFEGC report
